# Name a Seat - Terms and Conditions

## Keeping Norden Farm at the HeART of the Community

- Seats are regularly moved within the Courtyard Theatre, therefore the plaques cannot be placed on a fixed, predetermined seat.
- For the same reason, naming a seat does not give you the right to sit on a specific seat for a performance.
- Norden Farm reserves the right to refuse any dedication that may be deemed inappropriate or offensive.
- The intention is to sell sufficient number of seats so that all the seats in the Courtyard Theatre can be refurbished. Accordingly, plaques will not be installed until the whole refurbishment is completed.
- In the event of insufficient seats being sold, and the seat refurbishment not proceeding, the monies collected will be used for general arts centre maintenance and improvements, and the plaques will be displayed on the wall leading to the theatre instead of on the back of a seat.
- The plaques will be displayed on the seats for 10 years from the date they are installed, or longer at the discretion of Norden Farm, unless there is a fundamental reconfiguration of the Courtyard Theatre before the expiry of the 10 years, in which case the plaques will be suitably re-sited.
